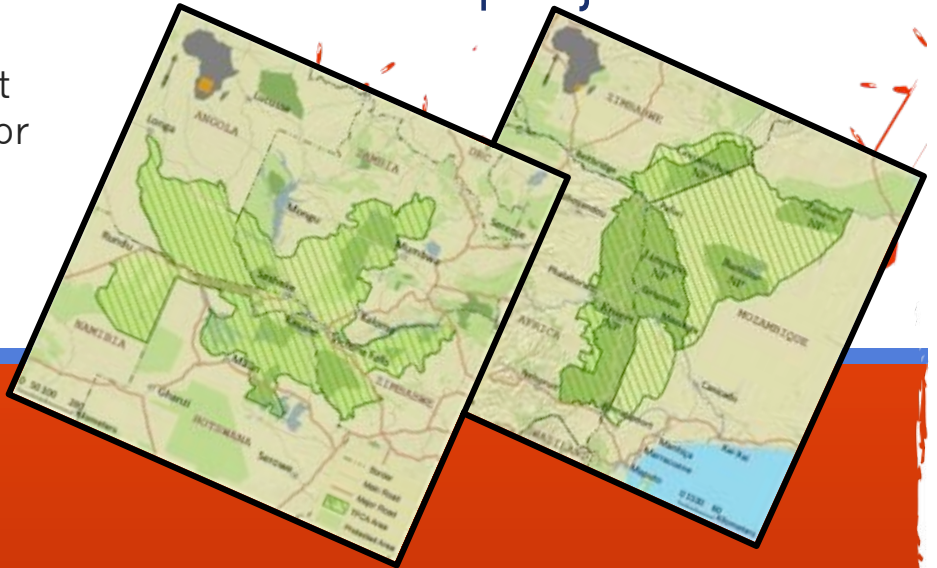

### Choose your way in...

#### ➤ Paper presentation:

Select a theme, send an abstract and know that you will have 20 minutes present and discuss your research.

#### ➤ Speed presentation:

Only Themes 1, 2 and 3 have speed presentation, of 10 minutes each. You will still need to send an abstract.

#### ➤ Poster and video:

On the evening of arrival, there will be a social gathering, where you can showcase posters and video of your work – be creative!

The poster will remain for the full length of the conference.

An independent thematic panel will review the abstracts and select the most relevant proposals for each paper thematic session.

Speed presentation abstracts will also be evaluated per theme.

- Authors (with speaker underline);
- Summary 300 words;
- State: poster, video, paper presentation or mini presentation;
- Font: Times New Roman, 12pts
